Scholarship Qualifications:

- Scholarships shall be awarded to individuals with neurological disabilities, or the child of that person, for post high school education.
- Individuals suffering from a direct spinal cord injury or disease resulting in paralysis such as spinal tumors, strokes or aneurysms affecting the spinal cord, or spina bifida are given first priority. Other diseases and disorders considered include MS, traumatic brain injuries, Parkinson disease and cerebral palsy. Conditions such as ADHD or dyslexia do not qualify.
- Priority is given to people living in Wisconsin, but scholarships still may be given out to individuals residing elsewhere in the United States depending on available funds.
- Applicant must be college bound: 4-year degree, 2-year associate degree or post graduate work. Applicants must have a high school or college GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- There are no income restrictions.

Guidelines:

- Review scholarship criteria below before completing the application. Answer all questions as completely and as accurately as possible, including all necessary attachments.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail.
- The following items must be received by the deadline date:
 - Application
 - Official transcripts (high school, college, etc.)
 - Letter of recommendation
